EMERGENCY SERVICES

If eligible, a person who is homeless, rough sleeping or at risk of becoming homeless may be able to access emergency accommodation, which may be arranged until a more long-term accommodation solution can be put in place.

Present to the Housing section in the Council's office between 9.30am and 1pm Monday - Friday at County Hall, Riverside, Sligo or call 071 9111177.

Outside these hours, contact Sligo Social Services, Maryville Hostel, Finisklin, Sligo where an initial assessment will be carried out. An emergency placement may be allocated subject to eligibility and availability. Any such persons will be required to attend the Housing Section, Sligo County Council, County Hall, Riverside, Sligo for a full assessment on the next working morning between the hours of 9.30am – 1pm.
